Leader Responsibilities

Prepare and Lead the Meeting

As a group leader, you will be expected to utilize one of the following for the Life Group Semester. **We highly encourage all Leaders to use the weekly Sermon Based study.**

- Sermon Based Study
- Book of the Bible
- Outside Curriculum

It is the responsibility of the leader to prepare for and lead or facilitate the weekly group meeting.

Attend All Training Meetings

For New Leaders we have a 1.5 hour “Rookie Training” at the church. This is for both husbands and wives. It will occur directly after the Saturday morning semester Kickoff and will last from 11am-12:30pm.

For all leaders our semester Kickoff will occur the Saturday morning before each semester. It will be at Hopes Raleigh Campus from 9am-11am

Ongoing Training is provided in the form of Training Emails and 1 in-service training per semester. You will be notified of the dates.

Track the Needs of the Group Members

As a group leader, you will often be the first line of spiritual defense in the lives of your group members. It will be your responsibility to keep in touch with the spiritual pulse of the people in your group

Communicate Special Needs Up-Line to Your Coach and/or Pastor

It's possible that some issues will surface in your group or in a member's life that are beyond your experience, expertise, or comfort zone. In that case, communicate your concerns up-line to either your coach or one of the pastors on staff for guidance or additional help.
